
## **How to Help**

# Independence is only the beginning...

Turning 18 and becoming an adult should be a joyous occasion, but many young people in foster care emancipate into less-than-ideal circumstances:

- Only 54% of foster youth complete high school.
- Only 10% of former foster youth attempt higher education; less than 3% actually obtain a degree.
- 51% of emancipated foster youth are unemployed.
- 40% of foster youth are homeless within a year of emancipation.
